Looking for a safe home you can afford to buy?

Are you a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident (landed immigrant)?

Do you live in housing that does not meet your family's needs? It may be in poor shape, too costly, unhealthy, unsafe or too small.

Do you have steady employment, but can't afford or obtain a conventional mortgage?

Are you ready and able to contribute 500 hours of sweat equity (250 for a single parent family) to help build your own home and participate in other Habitat projects and community activities?

Is your total family income (before taxes) within these ranges?

3 persons \$26,527 to \$33,159

4 persons \$30,223 to \$40,259

5 persons \$33,935 to \$45,662

6 persons \$37,637 to \$51,498

7 or more \$41,339 to \$57,336

Note: Family size must be at least three persons in order to qualify.

In January 2009, Habitat will hold **three** public meetings in Ottawa for families who are interested in purchasing a Habitat home, able to repay an interest-free mortgage, and willing to partner with us.
